Dear MASH Parents, Guardians and Students,

Welcome to Physical Education at MASH! We are very excited to begin a new year with you. Please review the requirements and our policies for physical education class so your child is prepared for our activities.

PE GRADING POLICIES

1. Every student will have an equal opportunity to earn his/her grade by earning points for each class. Please see attached grading rubric for more information.
2. All students must wear uniform colors and sneakers to participate in physical activities.
3. If a student is unprepared two times in a row, a "Sneaker Alert" will be sent home to remind the student and their family.
4. Students who have a short or long-term medical excuse must have a written note from the doctor to excuse them from participating in class. Copies of the document must be submitted to the nurse and physical education teacher.
 - a. Depending on the severity of the illness or injury, a written note from the doctor might be needed for the student to begin participating in class again.

PE CLASS REQUIREMENTS

We are a uniform school at Mauro-Sheridan! We expect all students to be prepared for class - wearing uniform colors and sneakers! Please remember this is an active class - it is important for students to be appropriately dressed for every class while remaining in uniform.

Also, students must wear sneakers to participate in PE activities. If your child is not wearing sneakers, he/she cannot participate in the class activity that day due to the safety of your child and others.

- PreK to Grade 2: Red shirt, red shorts/sweatpants, or khakis (no skirts or dresses)
- PLEASE NOTE: Blue jeans are not a part of our school uniform. Also, work boots, fashion boots, slippers, flats, and sandals are not considered appropriate footwear for PE class.

We look forward to teaching your child how to appreciate physical activity and improve their social/emotional health through teamwork and sportsmanship.
